

Craft Project – Bunny Hutch

Materials

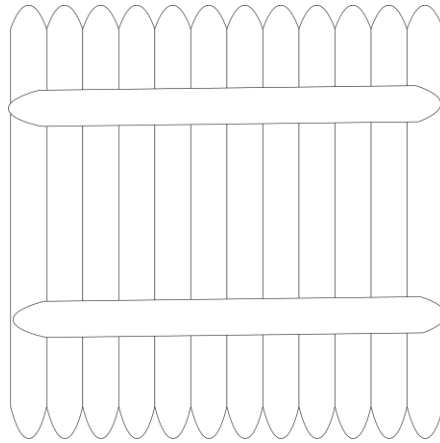
Craft Sticks

Hot Glue Gun and Glue Sticks

Cardboard, large enough for the bunny hutch to be glued to (bottom)

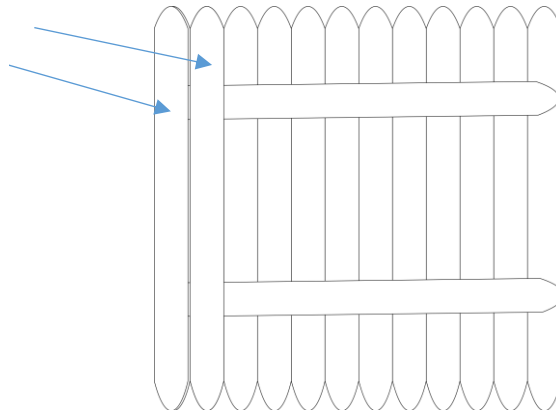
Directions

1. Make 8 sections with 12 craft sticks braced by two craft sticks going across the craft sticks to make the section as pictured below.

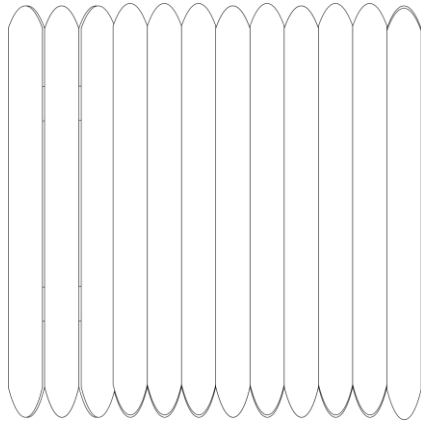


2. Add a layer over the top of this section, so you don't see the craft sticks going across. See below:

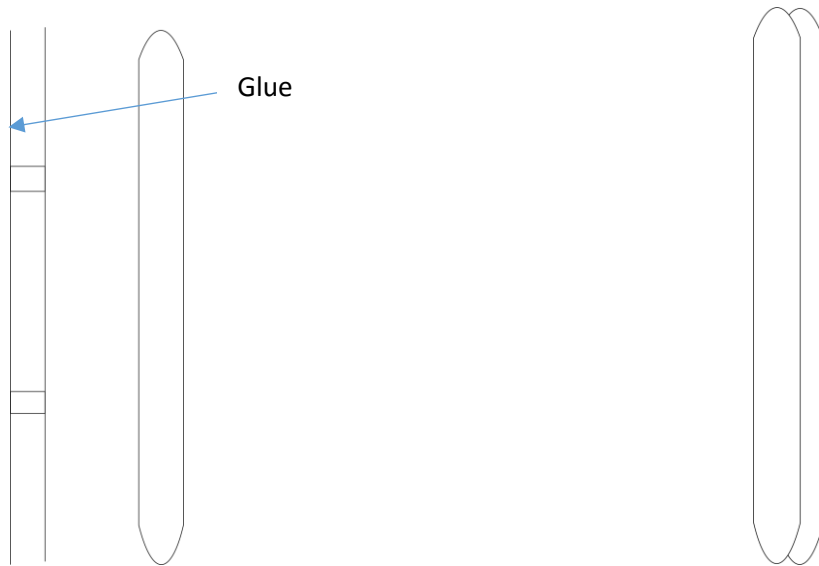
Glue craft sticks all the way across.



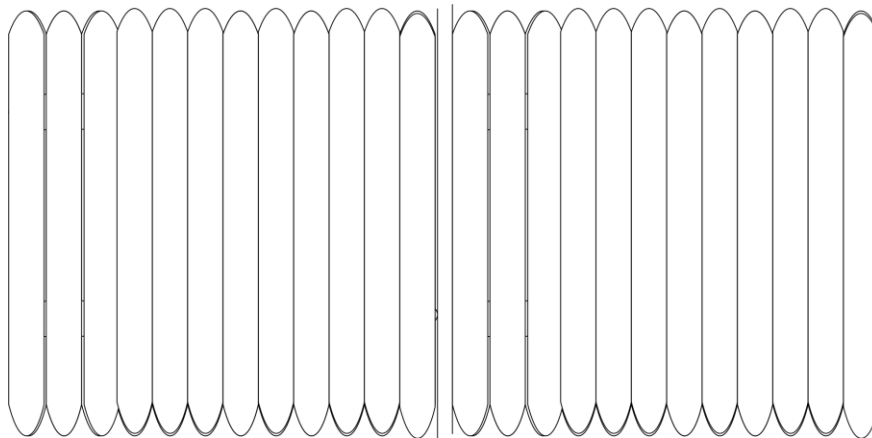
3. Make 8 sections that have two layers of craft sticks.



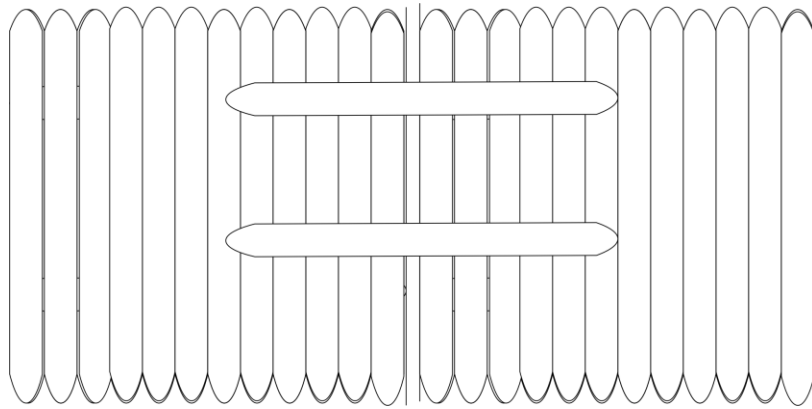
4. On each of the sections, we need to attach sticks on one edge. We will glue those two edges together, so the stick on the edge needs to be flat (not angled).



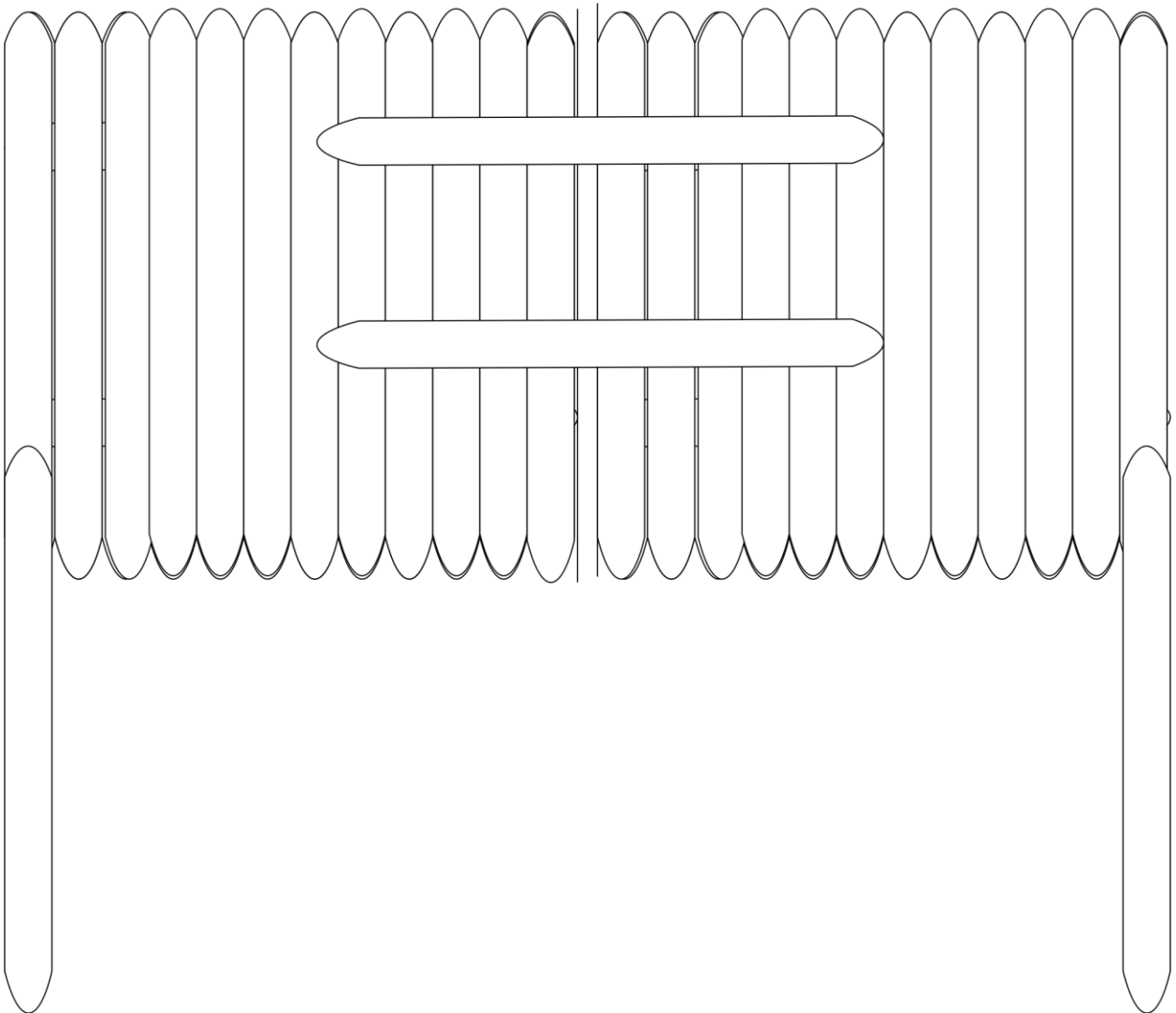
5. Glue two sections together.



6. To stabilize the double section, glue 2 craft sticks over the joint.



7. You should have four double sections. We will join the sections together.



8. Use the remaining section as a roof. It will cover the back half. Cover the front and front part of the top with a layer of tulle to simulate wire mesh.

9. Glue the structure down to a piece of cardboard cut to size. That gives your bunny hutch a floor.

Next, make a small bunny that fits into your hutch. Then, make carrots out of orange and green felt for food. Use yellow yarn to simulate hay. Put in a water and food bowl and your 18-inch doll pet is ready.
